

HIGHLIGHTS OF INTERNATIONAL AND CHAPTER MEETINGS



4TS, held in Dubai, UAE, has been organized in part by ISEVS President and co-program director Dr. Zvonimir Krajcer for the last 4 years and by our Arab Gulf Chapter. It was a great success, with more than 700 participants from the Middle East, Asia, Africa, EU, and USA.

ISEVS endorsed and several ISEVS members participated in the CADECI meeting in Guadalajara, Mexico, organized in part by long-time ISEVS member, Gustavo Rubio Argüello. There were over 3100 registrants at this international meeting, which presented the latest advances in cardiology and vascular surgery.



The ISEVS-endorsed Transcatheter Endovascular Decisions (TED) meeting in Scottsdale, Arizona, was organized by Dr. Venkatesh Ramaiah and sponsored by the Arizona Heart Foundation in conjunction with Abrazo Arizona Heart Hospital in Phoenix. The agenda included a celebration of Dr. Edward (Ted) Diethrich's life, highlighting his 50 years of achievements in cardiovascular surgery.
